SUBJECT: **2011 STATE 4-H AMBASSADOR & DIPLOMAT APPLICATION**

Enclosed you will find the 2011 State 4-H Ambassador/Diplomat Application. **Please remind all candidates that applications must be received in the State 4-H Office by November 15, 2010, not postmarked November 15.**

Please give each potential candidate that is qualified, mature, dedicated and responsible a copy of the position description and application, and emphasize the amount of time an Ambassador/Diplomat is required to spend in these positions and the financial contributions that are required.

- **NOTE –Ambassadors will be attending JOLT with the diplomats for their team trip. Please make sure your candidates are aware of this change.**

Interviews and selection of Ambassadors and Diplomats will take place on Friday, January 28, 2011.

If there are 10 or fewer candidates running, there will be interviews for just an ambassador team. If there are 11 or more candidates running, interviews will take place for both teams. The candidates will be informed about the selection process once all applications have been received by the deadline in the State 4-H Office.

Applicants must secure financial support from the County 4-H Council prior to applying (up to \$250 for Ambassador and up to \$250 for Diplomat). If financial support exceeds County 4-H Council's financial capabilities, the County Council, under the direction of the County Extension Agent responsible for 4-H, may develop a county level candidate selection process to reduce the number of applicants being submitted to the State 4-H Office.
