SUBJECT: Additional Expenses for members of the State 4-H Leadership Team

When you decide to run for State 4-H Council Officer or interview for a State 4-H Ambassador or Diplomat position, there are certain expenses that are required if you are selected for the State 4-H Leadership Team

State 4-H Officers, Ambassadors, and Diplomats are required to pay \$500 to cover expenses during their term. These expenses include travel expense to and from planning meetings as well as lodging and meals during the planning meeting. The State 4-H Office will contribute a portion of the expenses also. This \$500 can be raised through fundraising, sponsorship, or requesting assistance from a county council. Team trip expenses are paid for through fundraising the team does or personally.

Below you will find a table that shows additional expenses that may occur during their term. These are additional expenses that are not included in the \$500 that is requested when the youth begins their leadership position.
